## Apportionment Paid in Full!

Each year a United Methodist congregation pays an "apportionment" to the greater United Methodist Church. This apportionment (about \$150,000 for FUMC) supports the world wide mission of helping people physically and spiritually. The apportionment supports new ministries, ministries at colleges and universities, camps and a variety of others like Matthew 25 and our Flood Recovery office. The apportionment also supports the administrative arm of the church, salaries and offices for District Superintendents and others. First Church in Marion seeks each year to pay its apportionment in full (and has for many years). In 2009 our spending controls had projected paying 80% of our apportionment because of the economic conditions at hand; so it is with great joy that we announce to you that on December 28th due to the generosity of the congregation, 100% of our 2009 apportionment was paid!
