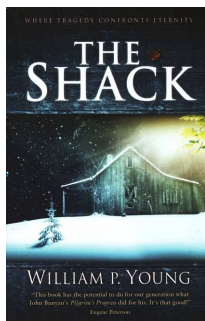
“Nooma” Class Starting January 11, 2009
