What is F.L.Y. ?

Over a year ago, area teachers gathered their passion to create F.L.Y. (Feeding Lunches to Youth and their families). This program makes lunches and delivers them to families at multiple locations in the Marion area when school is not in session due to extended breaks.

How has Christ grown F.L.Y. in the past 2 years?

F.L.Y. started as Christians with a passion. Our first meal fed 7 people. To grow, we began delivering food where children lived. Our hope was to feed 100 per day. As news of F.L.Y. spread and the FEMA trailers arrived in Marion from the Flood of 2008, the summer ended with 210 lunches per day. June 2009 ended with an average of **292 lunches** per day. FLY is preparing for 400 sandwiches in 2010.

What happens over the weekend?

On Friday, F.L.Y. delivers “take home” bags full of food with the lunches. Bags include canned goods, cereal, and hygiene products.

12:00-12:45—12 people needed daily

- Drive to Lunch Site to pass out lunches at 12:15 pm.
- Return leftovers and count sheet

1:00—Clean up—2 people needed daily
1:15—Delivery of Leftover Sandwiches
